- The night of SHAB-E-BARAT will be after *Salāt al-Maḡhrib* (8.42pm) on Tuesday 1st May 2018. Fast on 2nd of May 2018

The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) encouraged seeking the sighting of the moon. It was narrated that Abu Hurayrah said: The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Fast when you see it and break the fast when you see it, and if it is too cloudy then complete the number (of days) of Sha'baan as thirty."

It was narrated that 'Ali ibn Abi Talib said: "The Messenger of Allah said: 'When it is the night of the middle of Sha'ban, spend its night in prayer and observe a fast on that day. For Allah descends at sunset on that night to the lowest heaven and says: 'Is there no one who will ask Me for forgiveness, that I may forgive him? Is there no one who will ask Me for provision, that I may provide for him? Is there no one who is afflicted by trouble, that I may relieve him?' And so on, until dawn comes.'" (Ibn Majah)
