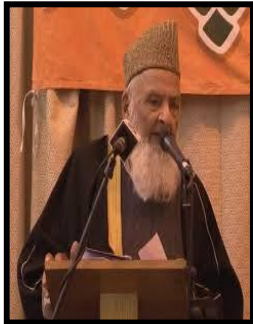


Eid Mubarak to you and your family, Stay safe!

Abu Ayyoob (may Allah be pleased with him) reported that the Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Whoever fasts Ramadaan and follows it with six days of Shawwaal, it will be as if he fasted for a lifetime."

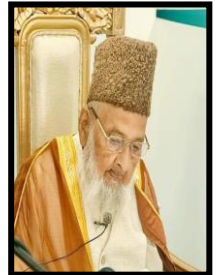

'Allamah Khaild Mahmud (r.a) was blessed to return to Allah swt on the blessed month of Ramadan, the month of mercy, forgiveness and where to doors of paradise is open.

He was a founding father of many institutions. The Muslims of Manchester are benefiting from the sacrifices the elders in the early 60s faced where there was no Islamic Institutions in Manchester

'Allamah Khaild Mahmud (r.a), was blessed with wisdom, intellect, knowledge and a long life.

He taught at Murray College, Syalkot, Pakistan as a Professor before moving to the UK in the 60s, was the first Imam in Birmingham based at the mosque that was established at Speedwell Road in Edgbaston. He established and co-founded many mosques around the UK. He obtained a PhD in Comparative Religion from University of Birmingham in the 70s. He established The Islamic Academy of Manchester (in 1974) He was formerly a senior member of the Sharia Appellate Bench of the Supreme Court of Pakistan and was world-renowned as a munazir and debater. He authored over 100 books including an 8 volume masterpiece on Barelwism entitled Mutala-e-Barelwiat.
